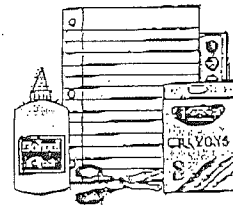

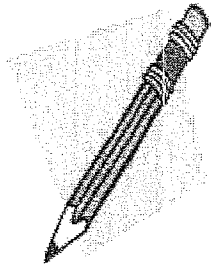

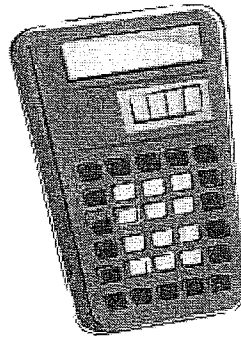

Expo Dry Erase markers – 4 – will be kept in math class

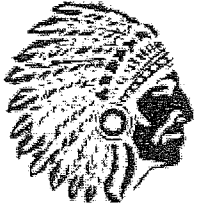
